

Seven thousand years ago a great personality was born. His name was Sadáshiva. A legend even in his own lifetime, and ultimately to be regarded as the father of human civilization, yet few know the story of how this great man became the god of all gods...

These devotional songs (*bhajans*) were recorded for the *Namah Shiváya Shántáya* movie soundtrack, based on teachings from the book *Namah Shiváya Shántáya* by Shrii Shrii Ánandamúrti. This film has at its core the renewal of a great and timeless message, still as relevant today as it was in times of old. Bringing to life the story of Shiva's fight for justice, righteousness and peace in the fledgling society of his day, that message emerges, in essence, as that of unification: the coming together of all people as one; of all minds as one mind; and ultimately of all minds with the Oneness that pervades and encompasses all things for all time.

The first song is a special type of bhajan known as Prabhát Saṁgiita (literally, "Songs of the New Dawn"), one of 5018 songs composed by Shrii Prabhát Raiñjan Sarkar. The other songs were composed especially for the film. See inside for lyrics.
